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About PhUSE

PhUSE is a global community of professionals passionate about the advancement of clinical information

With a membership of over 8,000 clinical data scientists worldwide, PhUSE is open to employees of the worldwide pharmaceutical & health sciences industries. This includes companies in the fields of pharmaceuticals, biotech and industry software solutions, as well as contract research organisations.

Run by volunteers as a non-profit organisation, it provides the industry with the premier platform for creating and sharing ideas, tools and standards around clinical data and statistical and reporting technologies.

Established in 2004 by Stephen Bamford, believing there was an industry-wide need for pharmaceutical and statistical programmers to exchange their ideas, thoughts and concerns, PhUSE began as a small society of 10 members. As interest grew and members joined, the first conference took place in 2005 in Heidelberg, Germany with 270 attendees. Now in its 13th year PhUSE has, so far, successfully hosted 13 Annual Conferences, 6 US and 2 EU Computational Science Symposiums and over 100 Single Day Events around the world.

Working in close collaboration, PhUSE has become the industry voice for regulatory agencies such as the FDA, EMA and PMDA, as well as standards organisations such as CDISC.

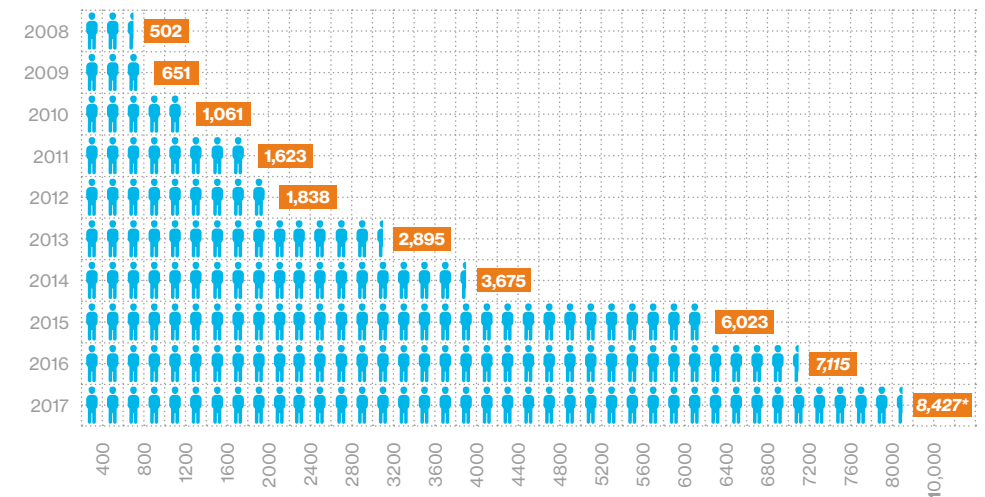

PhUSE Connect

A multi-day event held to give members the opportunity to connect, share, and advance ideas



As part of the rebranding of PhUSE for 2018, the Conference becomes 'Connect' to tie in with the new tagline 'Connect – Share – Advance'.

Featuring inspirational keynote speakers, hands-on workshops, discussion clubs, poster sessions and evening events, the annual Connect has established itself as the premier conference in Europe for clinical data scientists.

The PhUSE Connect is second to none with regard to networking and sharing knowledge, so why not get involved and give a presentation yourself? The 'call for papers' process opens six months before the start of the Connect. To submit a paper, you will need to provide an abstract giving an overview and one-page summary of what you wish to present. If accepted, a final paper and Wiki or PowerPoint presentation will be required.

Previously held in cities such as Vienna, London, Budapest, and Barcelona, the 2018 Connect EU will take place in Frankfurt from 4th to 7th November.

New for 2018

From 3rd to 6th June 2018, PhUSE will host its first Connect US in Raleigh, North Carolina. The theme will be 'Transformative Current and Emerging Best Practices' and the event will follow the same format as the Connect EU, with 10 concurrent streams, keynote speakers, hands-on workshops and social events.

The Connect ticket price includes:

- Sunday night Welcome Event and Poster Session, with refreshments provided

Key stakeholders from the product development and review process, including the FDA and CDISC, collaborate with PhUSE members to explore new ideas, solve issues and improve the product lifecycle. Held in Maryland, USA, ideas and projects contributed by members throughout the year are presented and discussed at this exciting and unique conference.

PhUSE was pleased to host its second annual European CSS at the Grange Tower Bridge Hotel in London, in June 2017, where PhUSE Working Groups gathered to participate in a range of cutting-edge projects. The event also featured two keynote speakers and a closing panel discussion led by the EMA & FDA.

CSS 2018 will be held from 4th to 6th March at the Silver Spring Civic Center in Maryland, USA.

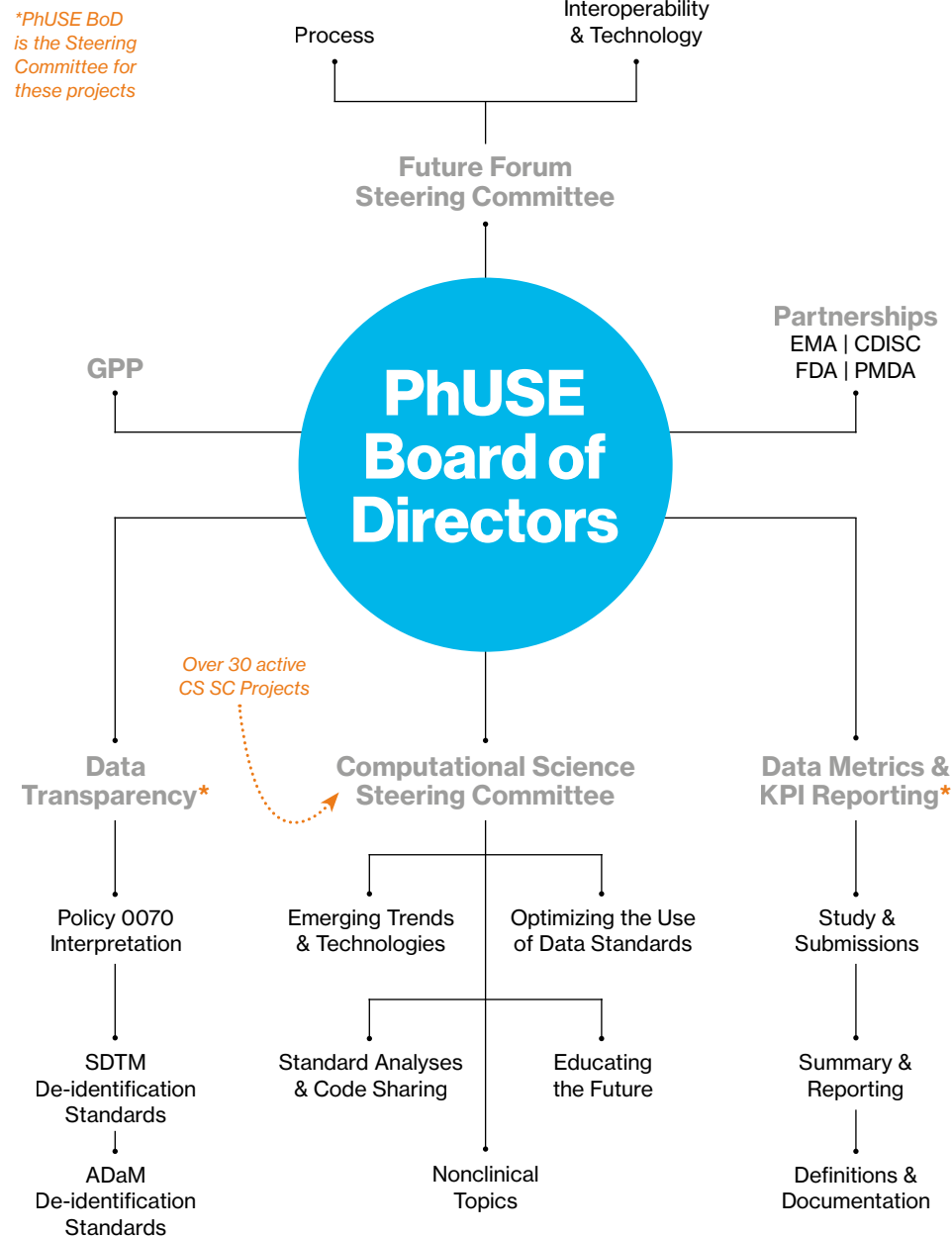

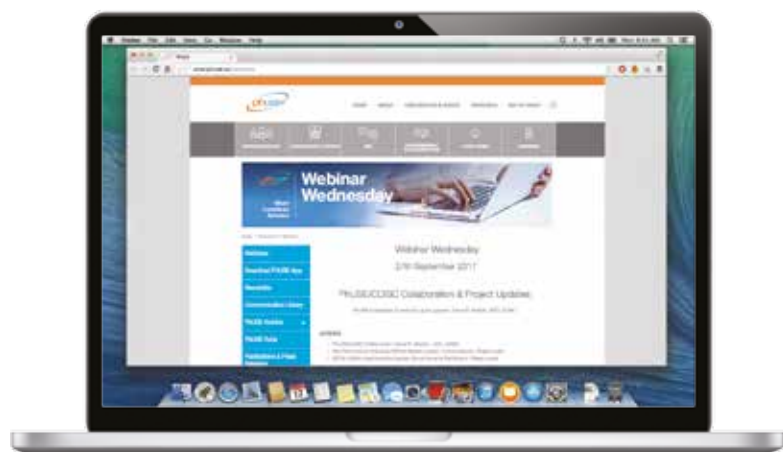
Webinar Wednesday
